

Insurance and Payment Policy

This office gladly files claims with contracted insurance companies and Medicare. Due to the ever-changing environment in the medical insurance industry we must have the most current and accurate information regarding your coverage. Therefore, you are responsible to present all insurance cards from the insurance companies which provide your coverage. We cannot file claims on your behalf without adequate information. It is also your responsibility to make sure that we are a covered provider for your specific group plan. Most insurance cards have a phone number on the back of the card for locating covered network providers. If you fail to provide our office with the current insurance information you will be held responsible for all charges incurred.

All “post insurance” balances are due within 30days of insurance payment. If your account is referred to a collection agency you will be liable for all fees incurred.

***All co-pays are due at time of visit.**

****Payment for services applied to your calendar year deductible are expected at the time services are rendered.**

*****Payment is expected the day services are rendered for all services not covered by Medicare or Private Insurance Companies. Please feel free to ask for a summary of Medicare exclusions.**

******If you do not have a Medicare Supplement policy, you are required to pay your 20% co-insurance at the time services are rendered.**
